PUBLIC NOTICE: UPDATE COVID-19

March 20, 2020

What is the Town of Fort Macleod doing during this pandemic?

The Town will continue to take direction from Alberta Health and the Alberta Emergency Management Association and in turn will share information through all our media outlets including our Website and Facebook page as it becomes available to us. Management and staff are debriefing daily to ensure consistent open lines of communication and current information updates.

CURRENT ACTIONS:

The Town has determined that in order to ensure continuity of **essential services** that it is in the best interest of our staff and department functionality that all departments begin rotating staff through a period of self isolation, limiting the number of staff on hand at any one time.

Having said that, we would like to inform our residents that some **non-essential services** will be unavailable and not a priority at this time ie: Recycling Trailer will be unavailable, cardboard bins at this time will remain as usual. All Town owned/managed facilities will continue to be closed and as of Monday March 23, 2020 all Town playgrounds and the Town Administration Office will be closed to the public. During this time Administration staff will continue to work at the office and be accessible via phone and email.

COUNCIL MEETINGS:

Beginning on Monday March 23, 2020 our Council Meetings will be live streamed via YOUTUBE. Council asks that only those persons with agenda items attend meetings at this time. Please note the following should you need to attend the meeting in person:

- All attendees we be screened regarding their health, recent travel etc. and asked not to attend if you have travelled in the last 14 days, show any sign of flu like symptoms or are ill in any way.
- We will be practicing social distancing and limited seating will be available.
- Hand sanitizer station will be available.
