

Positions are seasonal with an anticipated start date of May 6, 2024, and will end approximately August 30, 2024.

All positions will require you to perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks, and work in a variety of locations. Work includes but not limited to:

- Mowing, watering, maintenance and improvements of parks, sports fields, green space, and town facilities.
- Operating and maintaining equipment.
- Horticulture maintenance includes planting, weeding and general maintenance.
- Cemetery maintenance includes grass, tree trimming, painting, watering, and filling graves.
- Cemetery/Mower position will be required to work in multiple locations around Town and not solely at the cemetery.
- Other related duties as required.
